Your Responsibilities

- Make sure you have understood the duty of care statement
- You have read and understood the General Competition Rules
- You have read and understood the supplementary regulations and the important information in them.

If you believe you have been disadvantaged due to a rule being broken or have an issue with the behaviour of another competitor, or their crew, then please see your Rider's Rep in the first instance. Should they not be able to address your concerns then you have the right to lodge a protest through them to the Steward of the event.

These Responsibilities include

- Taking the opportunity for inspection of the track. This is the purpose of the "Look lap"
- Riding to the track conditions with due regard for the safety of other riders and officials.
- Obeying directions of all officials and medical personal.
- Signing entry and indemnity forms to signify your acceptance of the risks involved in participating today.

Ignorance is no excuse at this event

Everything has been done to inform you of what is required, there will be no acceptance of your lack of knowledge of the rules.

Safety Concerns

If you have safety concerns with the venue or the operation of the meeting you need to see me, or any other official, including the Rider's Representative. They will forward your concern to me, if I cannot satisfy your concerns then you need to consider withdrawing from competition at this meeting.

Prize giving/Final Results

- Provisional results will be "Posted" for 30 minutes before they become "Official Results"
- The protest must be submitted to the Steward of the Meeting in writing and accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 and must make reference to the relevant rule alleged to have been infringed.

Helmets are to be worn

- When astride any motorised Motorcycle.
- Camera mounts on any part of the motorcycle are subject to the approval of the machine examiner. No accessories of any type may be mounted to the helmet, goggles, or any part of the riders head protections.

Noise, Alcohol and Drug Testing

- This could take place during the meeting in accordance to the General Competition Rules.

- All riders, minders, family members riding around the venue, officials, observers, medical personal, caterers,
