1. I have read the Supplementary Regulations for this Competition and agree to be bound by them and the General Rules of MNZ.
2. I am aware that the sport of motorcycle competition might a) cause me injury; serious or otherwise b) damage my property.
3. I wish to take part in this event despite the above risks.
4. Neither I, nor anyone associated or connected with me will make any claim against you or your officers, employees or agents in respect of a) any injury suffered by me or b) any damage to any of my property regardless of how the injury or damage occurs.
5. I will indemnify you against all claims, damages or losses (including costs) which you incur as the direct result or indirect result of any injury to me or damage to my property.
6. I am physically fit and there is no health or other reason why I should not participate in the sport of motorcycle competition.
7. I am aware that this disclaimer will not affect any legal obligations you have to me which you cannot contract out of under New Zealand law.
8. I agree that in this disclaimer "my property" includes any property owned by me or in my possession or under my control.
9. I agree that this disclaimer will be binding on my family, my heirs, my legal assigns and my administrators and executors.
10. I accept that stripping and re-assembly of technical checks are at my cost.
11. I consent to the details contained in this form being held by the Huntly Motorcycle Club Inc for the purpose of the promotion and the benefit of the race meeting concerned, and motorcycling in general. I acknowledge my right to access and correction of this information. The consent is given accordance with the Privacy Act 1993.

Supplementary Regulations

- Points as per MNZ rule 6.15.1
- Refunds as per MNZ rule 5.6.2
- As transponder scoring will be utilized, MNZ rule 10-3-6-1 will not be enforced subject to the MNZ steward or their delegated scrutineer being satisfied that the machine is clearly identifiable. Rule 10-2-2 will still apply.
- Hired transponders will become the responsibility of the rider, any lost or damaged transponders will be charged to the rider or parent or guardian, at replacement cost. It is the rider's responsibility to return hired transponders.
- Attention of all competitors is drawn to MNZ rules around machine eligibility (MNZ 15-15-5). All entrants to this event enter on the basis of full responsibility to meet the requirements of this rule. A scrutineer will be appointed in advance by the MNZ Steward to enforce these requirements as they see fit. This may include placing machines in a "parc ferme", fuel sampling or other such measures deemed necessary to ensure fair and even competition.
- 96dBA noise limit must be met and random noise testing may take place
- The organizers reserve the right to alter format (including race duration and number) to ensure the event remains on schedule
- Entry Qualification
 - For Championship classes competitors MUST have competed in at least six MNZ sanctioned events as per MNZ General Competition Rules 15-2-1 and 15-10. Support class riders need only hold a full "mini" competition license.
 - Minimum 6 entries to constitute a class
- Qualifying
 - Championship Classes - Competitors may be required to qualify if numbers entered exceed gate number. Fastest 28 riders in qualifying will automatically go through. Remaining two places to be allocated by the Event Coordinator in their SOLE discretion.
 - Support Classes- No qualifying. Class close when gate full, as entries received (remainder put on waiting list)
 - If qualifying is required for any class this will be done by Electronic Transponder System.
- Tear offs strictly forbidden. Any competitor using or attempting to use tear offs may be excluded from the event at the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course.
- Dogs are not permitted at the venue.
- For reasons of Force Majeure, should the meeting or part of the meeting be cancelled, any entry fee refunds will be made at the sole discretion of the organizers.

Ladies Race

A one race ladies only event will be run on Sunday between round 4 and round 5 of general racing. Entry is open to the fastest 30 female competitors in the event based on lap times in practice and racing up to the end of round 3. This event will have separate scoring, trophies and prizes.
