This year we are pleased to include on Friday 20<sup>th</sup> May from 1.30 to 4.00pm the ACC Active Smart Programme Launch to be hosted by Joe Harawira, ACC Programme Manager – Sport. Active Smart is ACC's free online personal training solution which provides walking, running and cycling plans plus nutritional advice. The resource has been functioning for 4 years and has over 46,000 registered users. Active Smart was designed to target those people getting back into activity after a break or relative period of inactivity. Later this year ACC will be releasing an upgraded version of the site to increase the reach and impact of sports injury prevention and improved performance.

Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> May from 1.30 -3.00pm is the Recreation & Leisure Presentation, we have been able to secure Paul West from the Labour Department to come and speak to our members giving you an insight on the responsibilities for Clubs and Officials when holding events.

Saturday 21<sup>st</sup> May from 2.30-4.00pm will be a seminar on How fundraising creates independence, this effectively is a version of Fundraising 101 which is based on an internationally recognized course. It will cover preparing a case and selecting the right fundraising tools and the types of fundraising. Managing, planning and budgeting are key, volunteers, leadership and team building will be discussed followed by how to solicit corporations and foundations.

The seminar will be hosted by James Austin the CEO of Fundraising Institute of New Zealand, James has spent 30 plus years fundraising for the Not for Profit sector. An accountant originally with Price Waterhouse, James spent 13 years as a political organizer/fundraiser for the NZ National Party followed by becoming a professional lobbyist for the Building Societies and Finances Companies. He then ran a very successful international student exchange organisation and since 2000 was the chief fundraiser for the Wellington City Mission. In early 2009 he became the CEO of the Fundraising Institute of NZ – the professional body for charities and their fundraisers in New Zealand.
