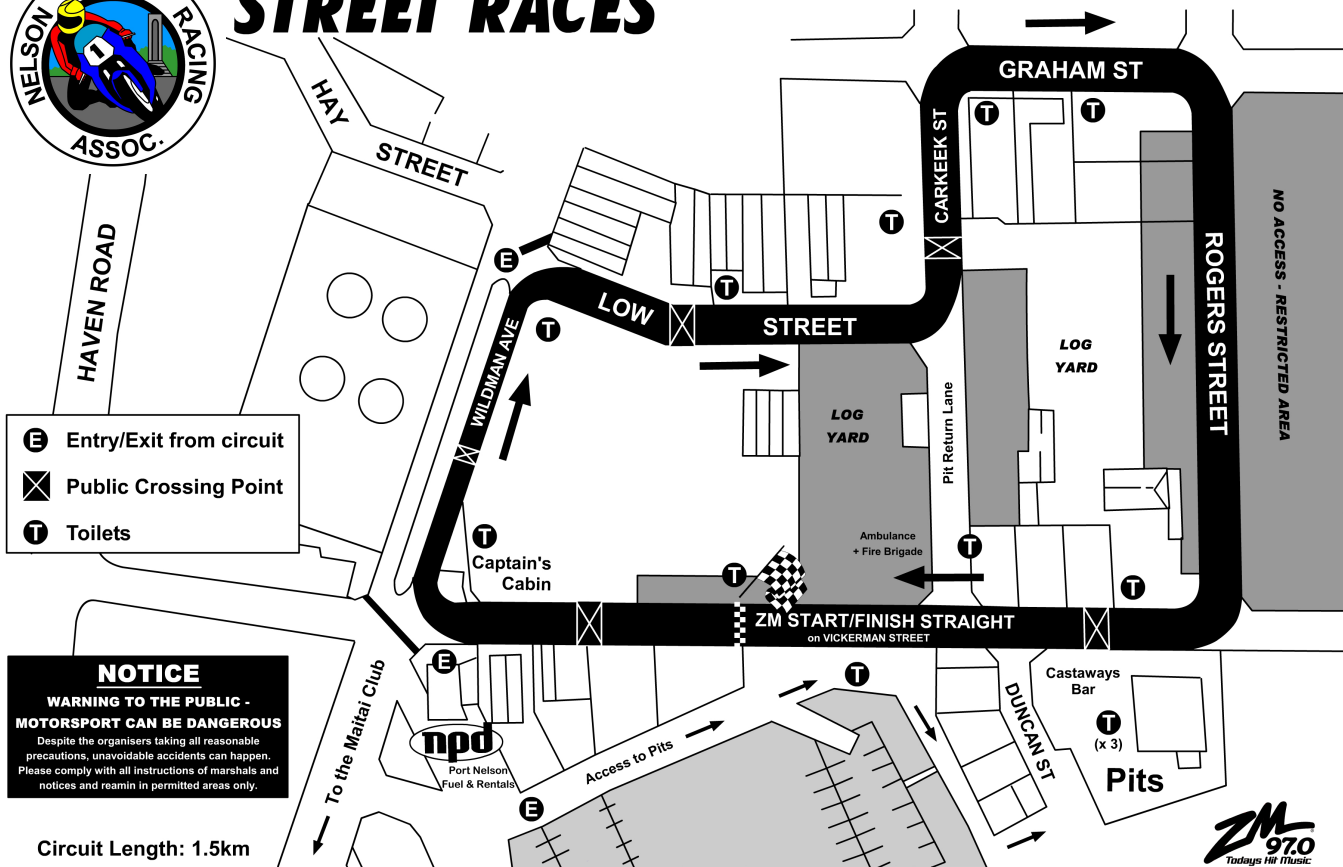

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The **Port Nelson Street Races** are a non-championship event for riders of a wide variety of motorcycles. Due to the nature of the circuit, some restrictions are enforced in the interest of safety and the long term viability of the event. For this reason please note that tyre burn-outs and wheelies are not allowed. The event stewards are aware of the difference between loss of front tyre contact with the track due to acceleration and intentionally "pulling a wheelie". The event is run under current MNZ rules and supplementary regulations put in place for the event. One event licences cannot be used at a street road race and are not available through MNZ.

### CLASSES:

Formula 1 B.E.A.R.S. Formula 2 Formula 3 / Pro-Twins  
 Supermoto Open Class (S1): 450cc and above Supermoto Class (S2 & S3): up to 449cc  
 Classic (pre 1963) Post-Classic (1963-1982)

The NNRA reserve the right to limit entries if races are over-subscribed and to handicap, split grids into classes or take other measures in the interest of safety or the orderly and efficient running of the event.

At the organizers and committee discretion, 10 competitors per class will be required for that class to run. A maximum of 35 will be permitted per race. The organizers reserve the right to refuse entry to machines which they consider to be unsuitable for competition.

### NO DOGS AND ALCOHOL AT ALL

Competitors, their family, friends, pit crew and associates are reminded that dogs are NOT allowed for safety reasons. Dogs and Alcohol is not permitted in the pit area.

We ask that everyone keeps it in mind that the event depends on good community relations in able to survive. Rider and spectator safety is paramount. There are no championship points at stake, please ride well and safely. Ride with the spirit of friendly competition that is a hall-mark of this and other street racing events.

## RIDER INFORMATION

**FUEL:** See MNZ Rule 10-17.

**Force Majeure:** Should the meeting or part of the meeting be cancelled for reasons of *force majeure*, any refund will be made at the discretion of the organizers.

**Licences:** Competition licences must be produced at the sign-on and scrutineering. As per MNZ Rule 22-8-15, riders must have completed at least 3 lower road race circuit events. Proof of this shall be from entries in the rider's log book.

FIRST TIME ENTRANTS at Nelson please send a photocopy of the last 3 entries in your log book.

**Practice and Briefing:** **MONDAY** morning: Riders briefing at 8.30am followed by practice from 9.00am.

**Sign-on and Scrutineering:** **SUNDAY** 1<sup>st</sup> January from 12.00pm to 5pm by the Dummy Grid/Back of ex-Castaways Bar, Vickerman/Duncan Street, Port Nelson.

**NB: NO SCRUTINEERING RACE DAY unless by prior arrangement, for out of district riders only. (\$50 late scrutineering fee)**

Scrutineers will be looking for:

- Tether switch/kill switch as per MNZ Rule 10-13-4
- Number plates as per MNZ Rule 10-2-3 (please read these rules)
- Securely mounted exhaust systems
- Baffles wired and silencers fitted (not to be removed for racing)
- Efficient brakes
- Brake and clutch levers must have a flat back, rounded ball ends and no sharp edges
- Brake pedal return stop on hydraulic type
- Handlebars must not exceed 92cm and be plugged or chopped
- Fairing blade edge rounded as per MNZ Rule 10-11-3
- Crankcase, gearbox, carb and air cleaner drain and breather tubes must run into a securely mounted catch bottle
- Drain plugs and oil filter retaining bolts must be wired
- General: wheel bearings, swing arm pivot, suspension, split pins in wheels, spokes, steering head bearings, all fittings, footrests, secure mounting of seat and tank
- Bike must be clean and tidy when presented
- Ethylene glycol is banned from use in road racing (MNZ Rule 10-13-2). The machine must be presented so that this can be checked.

**Tyres:** As per class rules, but treaded tyres are preferred. Trials and motocross tyres are not allowed.

**Riding Gear Requirements:** As per Rule 8-1-3.

**Prizes:** Trophies from NNRA.

### **Supplementary Regulations:**

Motards are only eligible to enter the Motard Class. No cross entering will be allowed. This is in the interest of safety.



## DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY

To the **Nelson Road Racing Association** and **Motorcycling New Zealand Inc.**

1. I have read the Supplementary Regulations for this Competition and agree to be bound by them and the Manual of Motorcycle Sport, the MNZ Constitution and the MNZ Code of Conduct.
2. I am aware that the sport of Motorcycle Racing might:
  - a. Cause me injury, serious or otherwise
  - b. Damage to my property
3. I wish to take part in the **Port Nelson Street Races** despite the above risks.
4. Neither I, nor anyone associated or connected with me, will make any claim against you or your officers, employees or agents in respect of:
  - a. Any injury suffered by me; or
  - b. Any damage to any of my property - regardless of how the injury or damage occurs
5. I will indemnify you against all claims, damages or losses (including costs) which you incur as the direct or indirect result of any injury to me or damage to my property.
6. I am physically fit and there is no health or other reason why I should not participate in the sport of Motorcycle Competition.
7. I am aware that this disclaimer will not affect any legal obligations you have to me which you cannot contract out of under New Zealand law.
8. I agree that in this disclaimer "my property" includes any property owned by me or in my possession or under my control.
9. I agree that this disclaimer will be binding on my family, my heirs, my legal assigns and my administrators and executors.
10. I accept that stripping and re-assembly for Technical Checks are at my cost.
11. I consent to the details contained in this form being held by the Nelson Road Racing Association for the purpose of the promotion and benefit of the meeting concerned, and Motorcycling in general. I acknowledge my right to access and correction of this information. This consent is given in accordance with the Privacy Act 1993.
12. MNZ supports the FIM/IOC charter on drugs in Sport. MNZ uses the services of Drug Free Sport NZ to professionally carry out testing. I acknowledge that by signing this form I may be subject to a drug/alcohol test at any time. I agree to such testing. I further agree that my name can be published by MNZ as having taken part in a drug/alcohol test together with the result of that testing.
