



Wanting to compete in Australia?

Any Motorcycling New Zealand competitor wanting to compete in Australia must obtain start permission from Motorcycling New Zealand. To be able to obtain start permission you must take out event insurance to the minimum standard set by the FIM (World Body for Motorcycle Sport).

You can apply for event insurance, by contacting Debbie Fraser at Risk Solutions debbie.fraser@fmrrisk.co.nz

It is not compulsory to purchase insurance through Risk Solutions, you can obtain your own insurance, but you must be able to provide a certificate showing the event details, venue and event insurance cover to meet these approved standards set by FIM;

PERMANENT DISABILITY	\$70,000	Euro
MEDICAL & DENTAL	\$15,000	Euro
REPATRIATION	\$7,500	Euro
FATALITY	\$35,000	Euro

Once insurance is in place and we have received a copy, the start permission can be processed and issued to you. MNZ will send a copy to Motorcycling Australia.

Want to relinquish your MNZ Licence for a Motorcycling Australia Licence?

For any Motorcycling New Zealand competitor wanting to obtain a licence through Motorcycling Australia the following applies;

- The competitor must intend to reside in Australia for 6 months or more.
- The competitor must relinquish their Motorcycling New Zealand licence, by contacting the office of motorcycling New Zealand.

It is the competitors own responsibility to ascertain what health benefits are available to them in Australia and to organise their own insurance cover if so desired.

The competitor will not be permitted to up-lift their Motorcycling New Zealand licence until the 6 month period has expired. After the 6 month period has expired the competitor may contact Motorcycling Australia to request to be released back to their Motorcycling New Zealand licence.

Should the competitor want to compete back in New Zealand before the 6 month period has expired, they will require a start permission from Motorcycling Australia which includes having to purchase insurance to the FIM standards.

Wanting to compete Internationally (excluding Australia)?

You will need to complete the International Licence application which can be found on our website - click the 'Information' tab go to 'Licence Information' and open the 'FIM Licence Application'.

Arrange your international event insurance as above and once we have received your International licence application and certificate of event insurance, this can be processed.
