



Motorcycling New Zealand - 2015 Rider Grants

The Board of Motorcycling New Zealand have set aside funds for rider grants for the 2015 financial year.

All applications for funding should come through an affiliated MNZ Club on behalf of the rider.

Clubs should be the first point of call for riders, all sorts of fundraising can be undertaken by the rider and the Club, after all of those avenues are exhausted the Club can then make an application on behalf of the rider (they should work together on the application), the application should include but is not limited to:

- The event/series they are attending, the nominated event must be conducted under a FIM/FMN permit
- The fundraising that has already been undertaken
- A budget of the total cost to attend the event/series
- The training and preparation that has been undertaken
- The professional attitude in relation to the applicants behaviour and approach to racing
- Past results
- How the event they intend to attending fits in with their overall plan for their racing
