The following is the format for the 2016 MNZ NZ Cross Country Championship, and the North and South Island Championships
Trophies and product prizes for final prize giving for Seniors and Juniors.
There will be 4 rounds consisting of two in the North Island and two in South Island. Your best three rounds will count for the New Zealand Championship.

- Round 1 - Huntly Motorcycle Club - Sun 21st February 2016
- Round 2 - Mosgiel Motorcycle Club - Sun 3rd April 2016
- Round 3 - Taranaki Motorcycle Club - Sat 16th April 2016
- Round 4 - Nelson Motorcycle Club - Sat 14th May 2016

For the North and South Island Champs points will be allocated to resident Island competitors. North Island Championship consists of three rounds, all three rounds count:
Senior entry fee \$70, Junior \$50
Round 1 Sun 10th January - Huntly (Round 2 Belray)
Round 2 Sun 21st February - Huntly
Round 3 Sat 16th April - Taranaki

South Island Championship consists of four rounds, your best three rounds will count, you must ride Mosgiel and Nelson:
Senior entry fee \$70, Junior \$50
Round 1 Sun 3rd April - Mosgiel
Round 2 Sun 8th May - TBA
Round 3 Sun 3rd May - Nelson
Round 4 Sat 18th June - Marlborough

NZ Championship Senior 3 hour Classes - entry fee \$90 (non-champ \$70)

- Class 1 201cc & Over Two -Stroke
- Class 2 0-200cc Two- Stroke
- Class 3 301cc & Over Four -Stroke
- Class 4 0-300cc Four- Stroke
- Class 5 Veterans (35yrs-44yrs)
- Class 6 Super Veterans (45yrs & over)
- Class 7 Women's Cup (non-championship)

You may only enter one class
Teams (3 riders), no entry fee

NZ Championship Junior 1.5 hour classes - entry fee \$60 (non- champ \$40)

Class 1 12-16yrs 4 stroke up to 300cc

Class 2 12-16yrs 2 stroke up to 200cc

Class 3 12-16yrs 2 stroke up to 85cc and 4- stroke up to 230cc

Class 4 Junior Ladies (non- championship)

You may only enter one class

Teams (3 riders) no entry fee

- Points will be scored as per rule 6.14a (Off Road)
- Sign on for Juniors is 7am to 8am followed by briefing then sighting lap. Seniors is 8am to 9.30am
- Please familiarise yourself with Chapter 13 (Off Road) of the Manual of Motorcycle Sport
- Full licence (Championship) required for Championship Classes
- Must use allocated MNZ numbers, as per rule 10.3a-f (Off Road), ie correct XC number and colours (blue disc yellow number)
