

## Motorcycling New Zealand Hall of Fame Policy

The MNZ Hall of Fame acknowledges outstanding performances of our organisation so their achievements in the sport are not forgotten and can inspire future generations.

While there are many variables associated with looking to compare competitive performance between athletes and in different disciplines the role of the board is to apply best endeavors to develop consistency and relatively to ensure credibility from one induction to the next.

The following policy has been developed in order to provide a transparent process:

- Any one person shall be limited to submitting one nomination per class per year
- Nominees are to be listed within one class only
- Nominations will be capped at a maximum of two nominees per class per year
- There shall also be a maximum of two posthumous nominations per year
- Nominations can be made at any time during the year, closing date each year shall be March 1st
- Names for posthumous awards may be forwarded to the MNZ Office for MNZ GB consideration
- Self nominations will not be accepted
- Official inductions are made at the MNZ AGM
