



Motorcycling New Zealand - Licence Renewal

It seems like only recently we started the 2013-2014 season, however that is all about to come to an end (30th June 2014) and we are now planning for the new season 2014-2015. The past 12 months have been very good for Motorcycling and Motorcycling New Zealand with notable achievements including:

- New Zealanders achieving great results whilst competing Internationally
- The hosting of the FIM Speedway Grand Prix at Western Springs
- Officials Training
- Coach the coaches
- Funding available to competitors
- Funding available to Clubs
- Coach the Coaches Level One
- Employment of a Marketing & Sponsorship Co-ordinator

Whilst we have had a good season, we won't be sitting on our laurels we are already planning the following;

- Improvements to the NZ Championship events
- More New Zealand teams competing internationally
- Coach the Coaches moving to level Two
- Continuation of the Officials Training
- Increasing the support by way of funding to competitors and the support for New Zealanders competing Internationally
- Continuing the funding to Clubs by way of Project Subsidies
- Building on the MNZ benefits programme

Speaking of Members Benefits, we have an exciting new members benefit on Accommodation, Motorcycling New Zealand has secured a deal with Choice Sports which provides all current members of MNZ with a 15% discount on any rooms booked in hotels in New Zealand, Australia or Singapore.

This deal is available for any bookings made whether it is a weekend away,

holiday or travelling to a MNZ event. You can also book more than one room using this rate so if you are heading away with friends you can all make use of this deal - for more info see [MNZ Member Benefit](#)

We also remind you that as part of your MNZ Licence you are automatically insured for accidental death (\$10,000) this is valid whilst competing at MNZ permitted events that require a MNZ Licence. All MNZ permitted events are also covered by our extensive insurance package to protect all of those at the event, Officials and Competitors.

At the recent Motorcycling New Zealand AGM, it was agreed there would be no changes to the fee's for the 2014/2015 season. There will be changes for the 2015/2016 season, however we will bring these to you in a separate newsletter to avoid confusion.

We have listed below the licence types that you can apply for; if at any stage you have any queries please do not hesitate to contact the MNZ Office either by [email](#) or phone 07 8287 852, if all of our lines are busy you will be required to leave a message, we will return your call as quickly as possible it will be the same business day if the message is left before 4.30pm.

Family Discounts apply to family members at the same address re-licencing at the same time, however you must either post, fax or email to us the form as unfortunately applicants using the **Family Discounts cannot re-licence using the on-line programme**, discounts are 10% for 2 family members, 15% for 3 family members or 20% for 4 or more family members.

Championship Licence: \$200 Senior & Junior; \$150 Mini Motocross, ATV & Moto Trials, Over 65 years free

A Championship Licence is required for all members who are competing at a New Zealand, North Island or South Island Championship event and Street Road Race.

Club Licence: \$100, Over 65 years free

A Club licence is for members who are competing at all other MNZ events (excluding the above-mentioned events) including support classes at Championship events.

Special Event Upgrade - for Club Licence holders:

Clubs hosting Championship Events (New Zealand, North or South Island Championships) excluding Street Road Race have the ability to provide at their events a Special Event Upgrade Licence. Notification of this licence being available at events will be made by the host Clubs by way of their entry form. Conditions of being issued with a Special Event Upgrade Licence are:

- Fee of \$50
- Competitors must indicate at the time of entering that they require a Special Event Upgrade Licence

- Competitor must have competed in a minimum of:
 - Seniors - 3 previous MNZ permitted events; Junior & Mini - 6 previous MNZ permitted events in the same discipline that the Special Event Upgrade Licence is being applied for, proof of which will be in their Log Book.
 - Limited to one Special Event Upgrade Licence per licencing year (1 July 2014 to 30 June 2015)

If you wish to compete at a Championship Event using this option check with the organising Club to ensure its availability.

To renew your licence please use the on-line system if you are able to [MNZ Online Licencing](#) you will need your user name and password, if you have forgotten this or for any reason do not have one please use the following - [Request Rider Login](#)

It does state that it can take up to two days for you to be sent your user name and/or password however you will receive it on either the same day or next working day that you applied for it (depending on the time that you make the request). Please do not phone the office for a user name and/or password as we are not able to provide these over the phone.

Alternatively you can download the renewal form - [Renewal Form](#) and either post, fax or email this back to us. If emailing you will need to print the form off, complete and scan a copy back to us.

You must be a member of a MNZ Affiliated Club before applying for your MNZ Licence, ensure you have renewed your membership. All MNZ Affiliated Clubs are listed on our website under each Region, www.mnz.co.nz - look for “Don’t ride alone, join the Club” on the front right hand page of the website.

If you have any queries regarding what type of licence you require, contact your local Club as they will be able to walk you through the process, or alternatively contact the MNZ Office.

We look forward to having you as a member again for the next season, for what is looking to be another great year for Motorcycling.

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
