- North Island Veteran Motocross Championship
- South Island Veteran Motocross Championship
- New Zealand Women's Motocross Championship
- North Island Women's Motocross Championship
- South Island Women's Motocross Championship

All applications for these Championship's must be in writing and submitted no later than **Wednesday 30<sup>th</sup> April 2014**. All applications should also include the timing systems that will be used, as Motosponder will not be a recognised timing system for Championship events – Clubs can continue to use it for Club events.

Clubs who have already sent in their expression of interest must also follow this process.

Included with your written application you should also include the following information:

- Event Outline
- Event Plan
- Event Budget
- Event Promotional Plan
- Event Media Plan

Once the Championships have been allocated, the successful Clubs will be sent a Memorandum of understanding between the Club and MNZ to outline all the details of the Championship.
